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WHAT IS IMAGINE ?

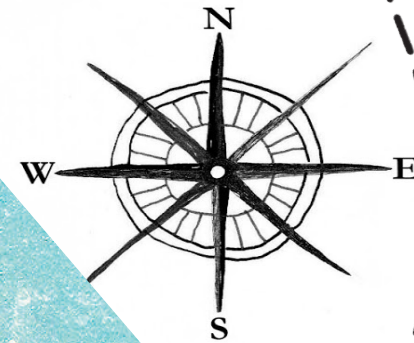

- Who / what helped you realise that Jesus is walking alongside you?



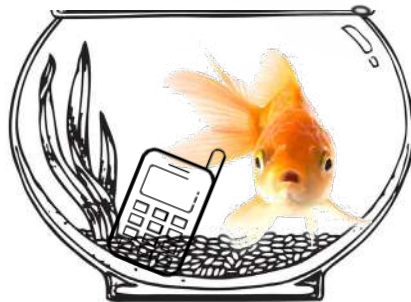

ENCOUNTERS DO IT YOURSELF PRAYER STATIONS



BUILD A BRIDGE

Pray for others. Stick "post it" notes with people / places you want to reach out to on a "bridge" made with two chairs and a plank.



GROW LIKE A TREE

Hang "leaves" on branches with words of how you would like to grow. Ask God's Spirit to guide you.



TEARS LIKE RAINDROPS

Hang ribbon or paper strips like "rain" to symbolise sadness / brokenness. Sit under an umbrella to pray for these issues.



MAKE WAVES

Look in the mirror at the bottom of a bowl of water and think about who you really are. Write the cause you support or your passion in the graffiti wall of waves and ask God to use you to make a difference.



CONQUER A MOUNTAIN

Use boxes to build a mountain and write things that you worry about inside the boxes. Now write names of God and promises you need to remember on the outside of the mountain!



FOOTSTEPS IN THE SAND

Take your shoes off and pray about your emotions. Draw a heart with your finger in sand (on trays) to represent God's love for you. You are not alone, He walks with you.



STONES – MAKE A CHOICE

Think of a choice you have to make and write one word on a stone. Place the stone at the foot of the cross while you surrender to God.



STARS – SHINE YOUR LIGHT!

Write your name in a star on a blackboard or light a candle as a promise to shine your light!

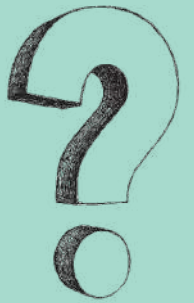

1. SAVED

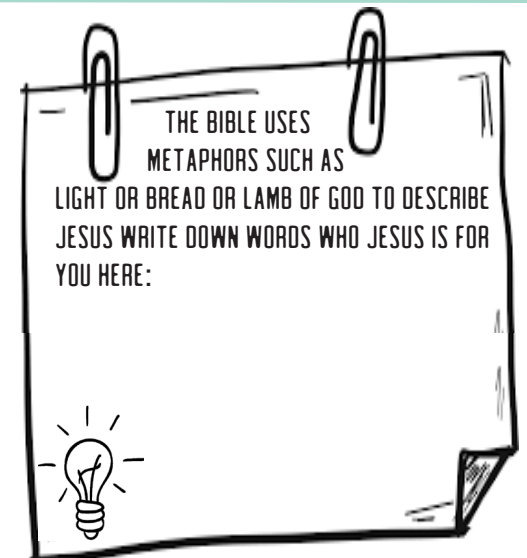
READ: LUKE 9: 18-20 PETER DECLARES THAT JESUS IS THE MESSIAH

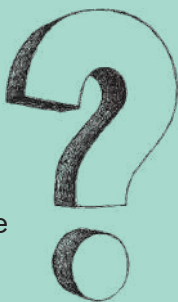

READ: LUKE 3: 21-22 THE BAPTISM OF JESUS

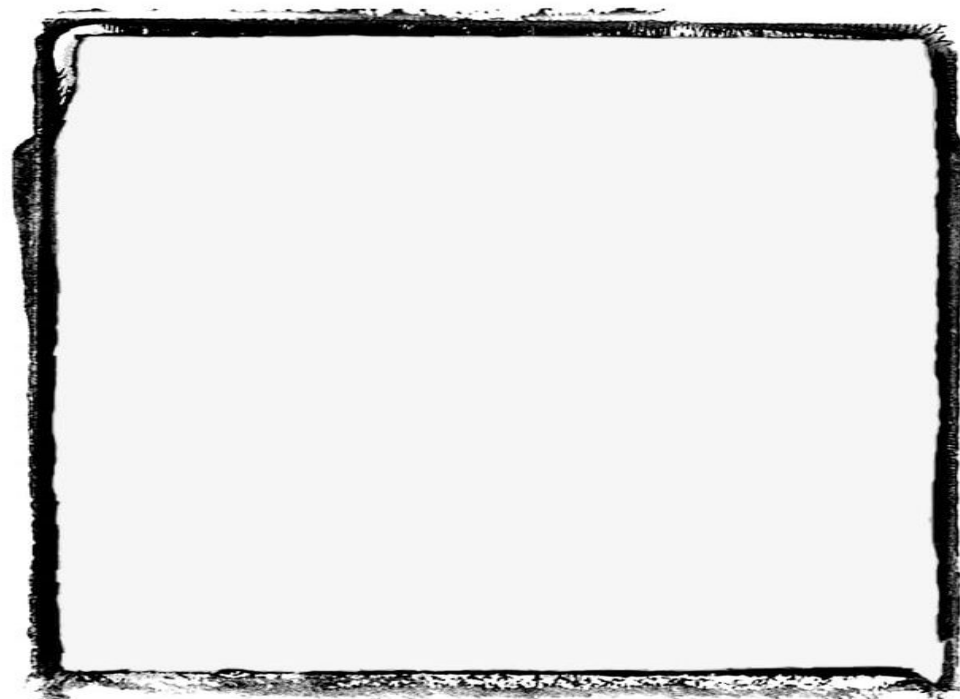

3. CALLED

READ: LUKE 9:57-62 THE COST OF FOLLOWING JESUS
JESUS SAID TO ANOTHER MAN: "FOLLOW ME!" (LUKE 9:59A)

- Discuss how you can find an accountable friend to help you.

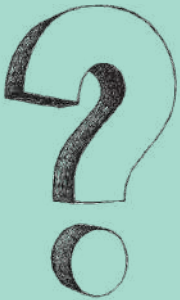


4. HEALED

READ: LUKE 17:11-19 JESUS HEALS TEN MEN WITH LEPROSY
ONE OF THEM, WHEN HE SAW HE WAS HEALED, CAME BACK, PRAISING GOD IN A LOUD VOICE. (LUKE 15:15)

Leprosy was a very serious, incurable and contagious skin disease at that time and lepers had to stay isolated outside villages, usually near the rubbish dumps.

- What do you think the desperate lepers thought and felt when they saw Jesus?
- What illnesses do you experience physically or emotionally?
- What are you grateful for?



CHALLENGE

ASK A FAMILY MEMBER, CHURCH LEADER OR ELDERLY PERSON HOW THEIR JOURNEY WITH JESUS STARTED.

- What are 3 practical ways that you can take the gospel to those around you?

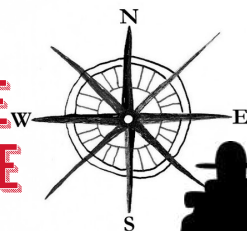

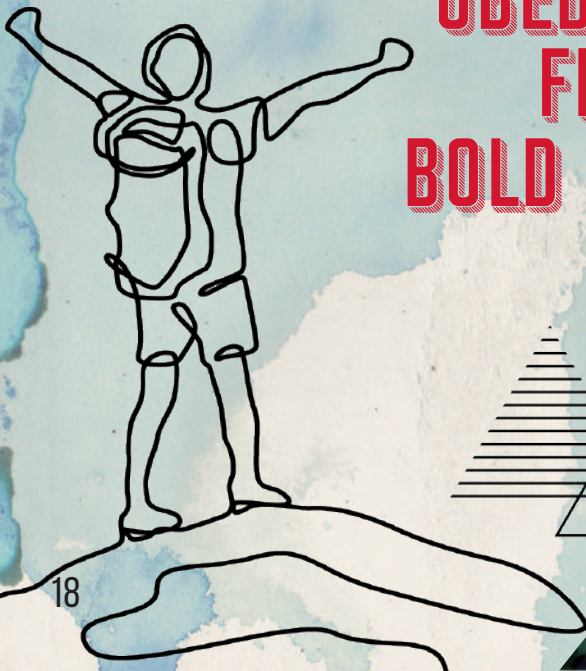

Jesus is taken into custody shortly before his crucifixion. The disciples love Jesus but Peter denies knowing him, because he is scared.

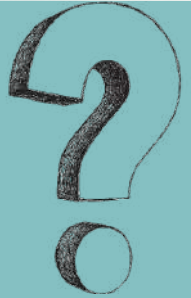
10. OBEDIENT

READ: LUKE 6:46-49 THE WISE AND FOOLISH BUILDERS

"BUT THE ONE WHO HEARS MY WORDS AND DOES NOT PUT THEM INTO PRACTICE IS LIKE A MAN WHO BUILT A HOUSE ON THE GROUND WITHOUT A FOUNDATION."

LUKE 6:49A

Jesus eats with Simon, a respected Pharisee, a church-man, but he also cares for a woman who had a bad reputation in town.

- How does Jesus treat the people in this story?
- What debt (or sin) do you have that you want Jesus to write off?
- How can you show with your attitude that you are forgiven?



12. BOLD

READ LUKE 21:12-19 SIGNS OF THE END TIMES

"AND SO YOU WILL BEAR TESTIMONY TO ME." (LUKE 21:13)

Jesus is speaking to his followers about the future and warns them about the persecution, hate and betrayal they will face. They need to be prepared to stand firm in their faith amidst difficulties.

- Can you find the 10 challenges Jesus names in verses 12-19 that his disciples might face?
- Name 10 challenges Christians face in your school and community.
- Have you ever experienced a hard time because you are a Jesus-follower? Ask a mentor or leader to pray for you.

READ: LUKE 22:39-46 JESUS IN GETHSEMANE

"FATHER, IF YOU ARE WILLING, TAKE THIS CUP FROM ME; YET NOT MY WILL, BUT YOURS BE DONE." (LUKE 22:42)

- How does Jesus react differently to his disciples in times of crisis?
- What do people usually do ("by default") when they go through a crisis? Name examples of how people handle it in the wrong way.
- What do you think happens in the heart and mind of someone who honestly talks to God in difficult times?

JESUS ANSWERED THE CRIMINAL CRUCIFIED WITH HIM: "TRULY I TELL YOU, TODAY YOU WILL BE WITH ME IN PARADISE." (LUKE 23:43)

- What are the different reactions of the rulers, soldiers, and criminals? Why do you think they react as they do?
- Have you ever felt far from God or unworthy of His forgiveness and grace?
- Think of the people in your town: the criminals, the police, the teachers, the scholars, the leaders... do you think they know about Jesus' forgiveness and grace?

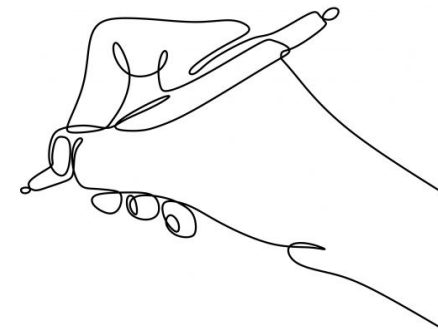
Jesus teaches us that prayer is a personal conversation, because we have a living relationship with God.

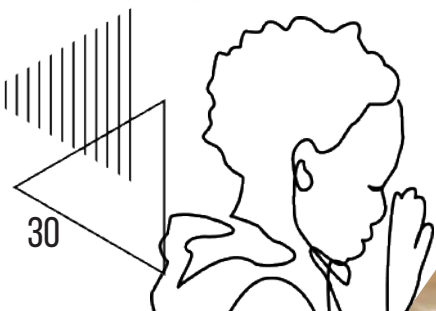

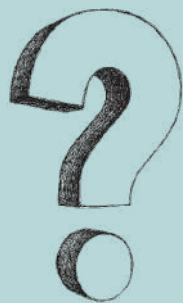
17. LOVE

READ: LUKE 6:27-36 LOVE YOUR ENEMIES

LOVE YOUR ENEMIES, DO GOOD TO THOSE WHO HATE YOU, BLESS THOSE WHO CURSE YOU, PRAY FOR THOSE WHO MISTREAT YOU. (LUKE 6:27;28)

Verses 27-30 give practical examples of how to surprise your enemies with kindness. Can you think of 3 modern day examples?

- Who is your betrayer, rival, frenemy, enemy or even perpetrator?
- How can you surprise or overwhelm them with kindness?
- This text can lead some people to think it is okay to accept violence. How would you explain it to them?



18. CARE

READ: LUKE 18:15-17 JESUS AND THE CHILDREN

BUT JESUS CALLED THE CHILDREN TO HIM AND SAID, "LET THE LITTLE CHILDREN COME TO ME, AND DO NOT HINDER THEM, FOR THE KINGDOM OF GOD BELONGS TO SUCH AS THESE." LUKE 18:16

- Why do you think the disciples rebuked the people?
- What does it mean to you to receive the kingdom of God like a child?
- In which ways can we care for people who think and do differently than you do?

8 out of 10 = how many SA children cannot read properly (PIRLS).

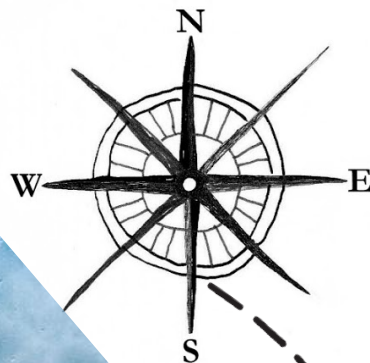
